Letter from the President

Hello NCTA!

I hope everyone is enjoying the beautiful weather and colors of spring! Our 42nd annual summer show is just a few short months away. Show dates are August 1-3, 2024 at Village Inn 6205 Ramada Dr, Clemmons, NC 27012. This will be our last show at the Village Inn. In 2025 our summer show will be held at the Greensboro Marriott airport hotel. More info on that will be given at our summer show this year!

The President's challenge this year is the rainbow trout.

We will be raffling off a Winchester SXP 12ga. Shotgun, 10 tickets = \$10 or 25 tickets = \$20.

New award: Matuska Competitors Award! You must have 4 entries in the same category - masters or professional divisions. All 4 entries must have a combined score of 350 or greater. They can be 4 different species or all the same or a mix as long as they are all in the same division. There is a \$25 entry fee to be eligible. There will be 2 awards presented, one for the masters division and one for the professional division winners.

Also again this year in honor of Mr. Jim Allred we will be awarding the Jim Allred award to the highest scoring mount between both masters and professional divisions donated by Jim Allred Taxidermy supply. All mounts must be mounted on a form purchased from Jim Allred Taxidermy Supply Co.

Bring all your unused taxidermy forms or items for our live auction on Friday evening. For every 2 items brought, you will receive a raffle ticket for a chance to win \$100 cash. Also if you have silent auction items please reach out to Vice-President, Ryan Garrison at (910)723-9029. The silent auction items will be placed on tables at the back of seminar rooms and bid on during our show. The winners will be announced at the end of our live auction on Friday evening, so our awards and dinner banquet can run more smoothly.

Banquet tickets are \$40 again this year. Membership fees are \$75 single and \$95 family. Show registration fees are \$45 before June 1st, after June 1st show registration fees will be moved up to \$65. Pre-registration is becoming even more important so don't forget to go online and pre-register!

I would like to personally thank each and every one of my board members for all the countless hours and dedication they put in for our great association so that all of our members can come together to have another great show and fellowship again this year. It wouldn't be possible without an awesome group of great taxidermy friends to work with like yourselves!
